

June Lee Olin, daughter of Walter W. (1903-1985) and Gladys Irene (Payne) (1903-1981), was born 8 June 1928, Michigan. She graduated in 1946 from Okemos High School.

June married Jesse Smith 3 July 1948, East Lansing, Ingham County, Michigan. Jesse, born 17 August 1926, Summerfield, Marion County, Florida, and June were later divorced. Jesse died April 1969.

June married Livingstone Latham, Jr., who became a US government realty specialist. Livingstone was born 20 January 1930, Michigan. He was the son of Livingstone Sr. who was a United State Marine Corps veteran of World War I. Livingstone Sr. saw action at Chateau Thierry and Belleau Woods where he was wounded severely in the arm, gassed and later was diagnosed with trench mouth. Livingstone Jr. was a USMC veteran of the Korean Conflict and a 1957 graduate of Michigan State University. He married Patricia Sheets in 1953 but the couple were divorced in 1971. June and Livingstone married in 1974.

June died 24 February 2014. Livingstone died 25 February 2014. They were inured Evergreen Cemetery, Lansing, Ingham County.
