

Did you know this about your classmate Harold Reeves?

From the February 1, 1949 Lansing State Journal:

From Japan comes a story of an Okemos boy who made good in army football. He is Cpl. Harold L. Reeves, son of Mr. and Mrs. A. L. Reeves of Mason. Harold played football for the Chiefs when in high school.

The former Okemos player played right guard on the air force championship team the past fall. Enlisting in 1946, he went to Japan in February, 1947, and played with the JAMA Marauders that year, but he reached the heights the past season.

Along with three other members of his team, Cpl. Reeves was in the lineup for every game of the season and was selected at the completion of the year as an All-Air Force guard. He played in the New Year's Day game against the Ground Force All-Stars in historic Nile Kinnick stadium.

Note: Nile Kinnick stadium is at the University of Iowa in Iowa City, Iowa.
