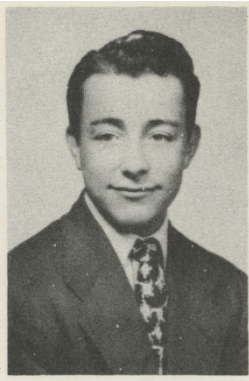

Upon graduation Harwood entered the United States Air Force and had a 24 year military career which included active duty during the Korean Conflict and the Vietnam War.
