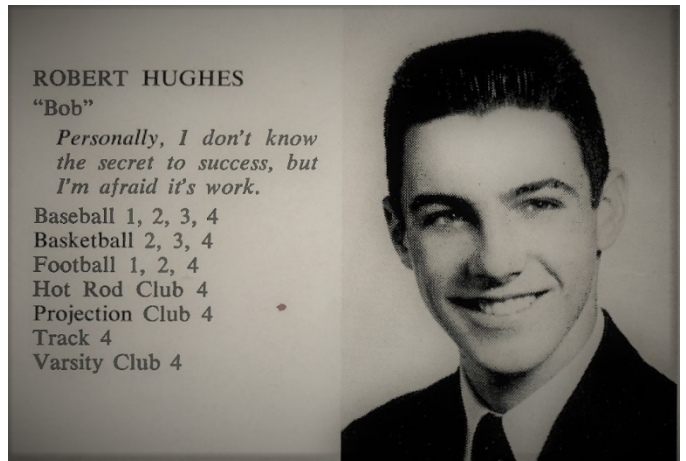
Our hearts are broken as we announce the passing of our beloved husband, father and papa, Robert Monroe

Robert graduated from Okemos High School in 1955. He then spent two years in the United States Army as an honor guard.

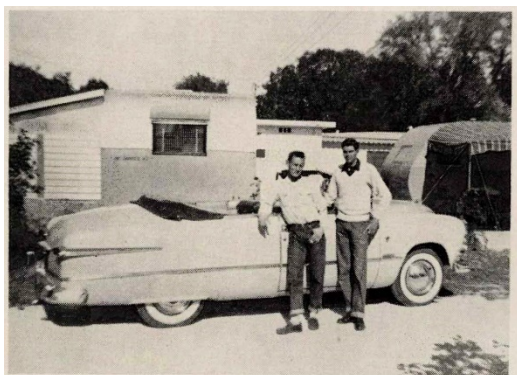
He had a
