Michael Sleeter "Mike" Kistler, son of Dr. Mark Oliver (1918-1995) and Joann (Rohde) (1927-2016) Kistler, was born 7 November 1952. Mike's father taught German language and



literature at Michigan State University for 40 years. His mother was also a schoolteacher in Ingham County. Mike graduated in 1970 from Okemos High School. He was an academic top 10 and a multi-sport varsity athlete. Mike attended



Michigan State University and a walk-on to the varsity football team. He was college sophomore when he took his own life. Mike died 10 August 1971 and was interred in the Kistler family burial grounds, Ebenezer Union Cemetery, New Tripoli, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania.
