Beulah E. Hager, daughter of Chester C. (1877-1940) and Ethel (Krebs) (1879-1972) Hager, was born 21 June 1903, Sunfield Township, Eaton County, Michigan. Beulah received her teaching degree in 1925 from Michigan State Normal School, Ypsilanti, Washtenaw County, Michigan.



She taught at Okemos Consolidated School from 1925 until May 1927.

Beulah taught in Eaton County until her marriage, 2 January 1937, to George Fayman Green. George, born 29 May 1898, listed his occupation on the marriage license as "buttermaker." After the wedding the couple settled in Hicksville, Defiance County, Ohio. The 1940 US Federal Census enumerated Beulah in the household with both George and George's 79 year old mother, Harriet. George and Beulah did not have children.

Beulah died 16 May 1956, Hicksville. George died 6 September 1956, Defiance County. They were interred Sunfield Cemetery, Sunfield, Eaton County.
