

Mary Louise Schultz, daughter of Bruce Carlton (1892-1953) and Grace (Hoerner) (1900-1934) Ames, was born 8 July 1929, Jackson County, Michigan. Mary's mother Grace succumbed to nephritis when Mary was only 5. After her death Mary was raised by foster parents Alexander A. "Allie" (1881-1966) and Ruby (Hoerner) (1893-1970) Schultz. Mary, as did her brother Johnnie, used the surname Schultz throughout schooling years. Mary graduated in 1948 from Okemos High School.



On 25 February 1949 Mary wed Lawrence Ray Sherman in East Lansing, Ingham County, Michigan. Lawrence, born 2 September 1928, was a US Navy veteran, 1946-1948.

Lawrence died 10 October 2009 and was interred Chapel Hill Memorial Gardens DeWitt, Clinton County, Michigan. Mary died 19 February 2015, Lansing, Ingham County. She was also preceded in death by [her brother, US Army Pvt. John A. Schultz](#) who was killed in 1950, Korea. Johnnie also attended Okemos High School.
