2 more MSU shooting victims discharged from Sparrow Hospital

LANSING — Two more students critically injured in Michigan State University's Feb. 13 campus shooting have been discharged from Sparrow Hospital, MSU police said Friday.

The students, whom university and hospital officials are not naming, were discharged after most recently being in serious but stable condition, MSU's police and public safety department said in a Friday social media post. Sparrow Hospital spokesperson Corey Alexander confirmed the condition changes.

Last week, Troy Forbush went home after being hospitalized for more than a week. Two other students remain in the hospital – one in fair condition, another in critical – according to MSU police.

A man shot and killed MSU students Brian Fraser, Alexandria Verner, and Arielle Anderson on Feb. 13 and wounded five others.
