Thank you for submitting initial forms and related information. Determinations are based on Michigan laws for registering charities, the Charitable Organizations and Solicitations Act (COSA), MCL 400.271 *et seq.* and the Supervision of Trustees for Charitable Purposes Act (STCPA), MCL 14.251 *et seq.*

This organization is now registered under COSA. The enclosed certificate explains your responsibilities to renew and notify us of changes made in the organization. This registration is separate from requirements of other agencies. Professional fundraisers hired to plan, carry out solicitation campaigns, or solicit or receive funds in Michigan must be licensed by our office. Send a copy of the IRS 501(c)(3) determination when received.

This organization is also now registered as a charitable trust under STCPA. STCPA registration requires an annual financial report. Annual financial statements submitted for renewal of the COSA registration satisfy the STCPA reporting requirement as long as the organization is registered under COSA. In the future, if you no longer are required to have a COSA registration, you must submit an IRS 990, 990-EZ, 990-PF, audited financial statement, or other acceptable accounting each year to satisfy the requirement.
